Spooky Showmanship -- Horse or pony to be shown in a Western Halter or English bridle at a walk and trot. The manner in which the animal is shown to judge to count, as well as neatness, cleanliness and condition. Western or English apparel to be worn.

Lurking Lunge Line – Horses to be shown in both directions for 45 sec each way demonstrating walk, trot & canter

Poison Pleasure - Horses to be shown at a flat-footed walk on a reasonably loose rein, trot, good easy canter. Not to gallop. To be judged on manners, performance, quality and conformation. No martingales permitted.

Entries postmarked after closing will be charged the post entry fee.

STABLING: A limited number of pens are available and priority will be given to those entries from out of the area. The pen **MUST** be cleaned out

Pens will be assigned on Friday night. Pens are handed out in order of entry received.

Please DO NOT put horses in pens that are not assigned to you. If you are bringing an extra horse that is not in the show, please fill out an entry form to be sure a stall will be assigned. If we run out of pens for out-of-town entries, the local horses will be asked if they would stable at home. Thank you for your co-operation.

GENERAL RULES:

- 1.** The Horse Association of Central Kootenay, is not responsible for any accident that may occur to any horse, exhibitor, or equipment entered at the show. Entry blanks must be signed by participants over 18 years of age as a condition of entry for this show. Parent/guardian must sign all entry blanks for participants 17 years of age and under.
- 2.** 3 horses constitute a class (classes may be cancelled, combined or divided depending on entries.) **No Champion awards will be given out for any division with less than 3 participants.** A person must show in 3 classes to qualify for high point. Entry fee will be refunded if class is cancelled.
- 3.** All competitors must wear proper riding boots and horses must be properly equipped. **Approved riding helmets are mandatory for child and junior competitors** and strongly recommended for senior competitors.

4. Riders using abusive language or mistreating horses in any way may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be disqualified from the show. The committee may also disqualify any horses which appear ill or lame.
5. Horses must be under rider/handler control at all times or they will be asked to leave the grounds. Stallions must be noted on the entry form **and NOT be shown by a child or junior competitor.**
6. Horses not entered in the show will not be allowed on the Exhibition grounds. Horses not allowed in the concession area or spectator area.
7. Child or Junior competitors entering a horse owned by another must have the owner's signature on their entry forms signed by a parent or guardian. Anyone entering a horse owned by someone else must have the owner's signature on their entry forms.
8. **All participants must have a current HCBC membership, and provide proof of membership. If not, you will be asked to fill out a membership form or affidavit and your membership will be checked on Monday.**
9. The Judges decision will be final. Protests shall be made in writing the same day and presented to the Steward, accompanied by a \$50.00 fee.
10. Any exhibitor wearing the wrong number in the ring or having no number at all, may be excused from the ring.
11. **Horses that are known to kick are asked to exhibit a red ribbon on their tail to warn other riders.**
12. The organizing committee reserves the right to decide any point not covered in the rules and regulations and to correct any error or make any alterations that may be necessary in the prize list.
13. **HCBC rules will prevail.**
14. **Gate holds:** You may request a gate hold if you have back-to-back classes, in which you are changing horse, tack or rider. If no gate hold is requested you will only have 3 calls and then the gate will be closed and you will miss your class. **No refund for class.**
15. If you are riding 2 horses, please have appropriate tack for both horses as the long delays for tack changes makes for a very long day.
16. **No person**, other than the show committee, shall enter the judging area and/or hold a conversation with the judge during show hours. The show committee shall arrange a time and place, if you wish to talk to the judge regarding a decision.
17. Dogs must be on a leash.
18. Neither the horse show committee, Horse Association of Central Kootenay, or their volunteers assume any responsibility for accidents or injuries to the horse, handler, spectator or their property while attending the show.
19. The presentation and signing of your release waiver(s) shall be deemed acceptance of these rules and regulations and absolve the horse show committee of responsibility and liability.
20. **There will be no switching of classes. Be sure you are entered in the proper class.**
